Medical Control Agreement additions under the 2017 NYS EMS Collaborative Protocols

## **Background**

Specific North Country Medical Control Agreement requirements

As an Advanced Provider/Agency in the North Country Regional EMS System you agree to:

- Maintain membership in a regionally approved Advanced Life Support Agency
- Maintain registration in the Regional EMS Online system and send required documents to the North Country EMS Program Agency.
- Successful Completion of the appropriate level protocol exam
- Participation in the regional continuing medical education and skills maintenance program
- Participation in the regional quality assurance program.

In return the North Country REMAC agrees to authorize you to practice in the regional system at the level at which you are currently certified by NYS.

If you deviate from the protocols in such a manner as to endanger, potentially endanger a patient or employ a skill improperly, you may be subject to suspension of privileges by the Regional Medical Director. If your privileges are suspended (or practice limited), you will be given the opportunity for a REMAC hearing. All deviations should be done in consultation with a medical control physician to ensure the highest quality patient care possible.
