

# OGDENSBURG VOLUNTEER RESCUE SQUAD ANNOUNCES ONE (1) PART TIME AND TWO (2) PER DIEM OPENINGS FOR AEMT – CC OR PARAMEDIC

AEMT Critical Care or Paramedic - The Ogdensburg Volunteer Rescue Squad Inc. (OVRs) is seeking candidates for the position of Emergency Medical Technician – Critical Care or Paramedic for both Part Time and Per Diem positions. Ogdensburg Volunteer Rescue provides emergency 911 services to the City of Ogdensburg and surrounding areas. OVRs also provides ALS Intercept service for an approximately 325 miles. We provide both urban as well as Rural EMS. We also provide transports from our local hospitals to higher level of care hospitals wherever requested to go. Ogdensburg Volunteer Rescue Squad handled over 2,500 calls for service in 2017 and are currently on pace to pass those numbers in 2018. The selected candidate will serve in a combination Volunteer/Paid department. OVRs currently has 54 Volunteers ranging in levels from Driver to AEMT-Paramedic. Ogdensburg Volunteer Rescue Squad operates four fully stocked ALS ambulances.

**The Part Time position** will not include all OVRs benefits but will accumulate Vacation/Sick time and have other benefits such as Disability Insurance as well as Savings opportunities. The selected candidate will be regularly scheduled for 36 hours every bi-weekly pay period. The normal work hours will vary, some shifts may be 12 hours and others will be 24-hour shifts. The selected candidate will also be eligible to pick up additional time by claiming open shifts and also unscheduled transports.

**The Per Diem positions** will not include all OVRs benefits but will have some such as Disability Insurance as well as Savings opportunities. The normal work hours will vary and the maximum will be 36 hours one week. Some shifts may be 12 hours and others will be 24-hour shifts. The providers will also have on-call shift pay available for transports. The provider will request all openings and the Chief will select for the open shifts.

The position requires current NYS Critical Care and or Paramedic certification and all capacities of emergency care as a pre-hospital care provider and patient transports capable. There are certain general duties during shift, and special project assignments. Compensation will be based on experience and other related factors.
